

RED TRAIL: CLIMB TO THE SUMMIT OF THE VELETA PEAK

From the top station of the Veleta Chairlift, we climb to 3.396m to reach the top of the renowned Veleta Peak, the 2nd highest peak of the Iberian Peninsula. From the Posiciones de la Veleta we will be able to distinguish the different "3Ks" of the mountain chain and once at the top, the south face of the Granada massif and on a clear day even the Mediterranean coastline and the North of Africa.



GREEN TRAIL: "LAGUNA DEL LAS YEGUAS" LAGOON

From the top station of the Veleta Chairlift, we follow the path that leads us to the col of the lagoon, before reaching the Laguna de las Yeguas itself in full National Park.

Routes to relish the mountain freedom of Sierra Nevada*



YELLOW TRAIL: THE OBSERVATORY

We climb from Borreguiles to the col of the lagoon where we change slopes to make our way into the River Dílar valley which we follow to the Laguna de las Yeguas, in the National Park, before we finish our route at the highest observatory in Europe.



ORANGE TRAIL: **VIRGEN DE LAS NIEVES**

From the shrine to the Virgen de las Nieves at Hoya de la Mora, we walk along the Camino del Agua path until we reach Borreguiles.



BLACK TRAIL: LAS CHORRERAS- LOMA DE DÍLAR

From Borreguiles we head towards the River Dílar valley through the part of Montebajo. A path leads us into the National Park and to the low part of the Laguna de las Yeguas.



PURPLE TRAIL: LAS SUERTES DE SIERRA NEVADA

A tour through the area of Fuente Alta and its thick coniferous forest which allows us to learn about the way of life of the early dwellers of Sierra Nevada. This whole route is on foot and does not include transfers. FREE ACCESS: TICKETS AND GUIDES ARE NOT NECESSARY

Use of comfortable mountain footwear, sun cream, sun glasses and water is obligatory. All activities are subject to weather and operational conditions.

EBIKE ROUTES

SPRING/ SUMMER (from 2nd May to 25th August)

ROUTE: FUENTE ALTA

(8KM, 1hr, 140m slope)

Ride along the circuit created for the 2000 World MTB Championship held in Sierra Nevada. Set in the Fuente Alta area, 1km from the Sierra Nevada residential zone, this is a very attractive route, almost entirely through pine woods.

ROUTE: VIRGEN DE LAS NIEVES SHRINE

(13KM, 1.50hrs, 475m slope.)

This route starts taking the road from Pradollano up to the shrine of La Virgen de las Nieves and then we have a variety of dirt tracks to choose from to make our way back down. Here, the difficulty lies in the climb, yet as this is done on electric bikes on tarmac does not require major effort.

ROUTE: SIERRA NEVADA SOCIETY LODGE

(14KM, 2hrs, 150m slope.)

We ride up along the road from Pradollano to the Sabinas saddle then the old road to Slerra Nevada through the Fuente Alta area. From here we follow dirt tracks to the Campos de Otero behind the San Franciso Crags until we reach the San Francisco Lodge and find an unbeatable view of the San Juan valley. Built in 1920 by the Sierra Nevada Society, the lodge stands at the place of Sierra Nevada´s first chairlift and where skiing started. To return, we retrace our steps.

ROUTE: DIECHAR- LA ZUBIA - MONACHIL

(40KM, 3-4 hrs, 1330m slope)

A route over all types of terrain, starting with the descent to the old Diechar power station. From there we go up to the Álamo col and then back down to the Cortijuela botanical gardens before a further descent to the Hervidero spring and La Zubia. We then end in the village of Monachil. This route includes a return vehicle to Sierra Nevada and the possibility of including a stop to eat in the Fuente del Hervidero or in Monachil.

ROUTE: DIECHAR POWER STATION - PURCHE

(32KM, 2hrs, 1325m slope.)

This ride descends along the old road to Sierra Nevada as far as the Dornajo crossroads. From there we follow a forest path to the Diechar power station, the Mimbres farmhouse and come out on top of El Purche mountain pass to end our route. We have the choice of either going straight back up to Sierra Nevada by car or having lunch. The ride from Dornajo onwards is very varied, we encounter both flat stretches, and climbs and descents as we enjoy the differing scenery of our surroundings between the mid and high mountain areas.

The addition of the option of stopping for a meal in El Purche restaurant will increase the cost of this route accordingly.

Use of comfortable mountain footwear, sun cream, sun glasses and water is obligatory.





EBIKE ROUTES

SPRING/ SUMMER (from 2nd May to 25th August)

ROUTE: GÜEJAR SIERRA – HOTEL DEL DUQUE – MAITENA (19KM, 1.30hrs, 1100m slope.)

Practically all of this route is a descent on asphalt following the old road to Sierra Nevada to the crossroads at Dornajo Visitor Centre. From here we take the local road from El Duque hotel which leads us to the river Genil and along to the old tram station at Maitena. Here we stop for a meal and even a dip in the river (summer season.) The contrasting scenery we encounter on this ride takes us from the pine forest at the foot of Sierra Nevada´s residential estate, passing through all kinds of trees and mid mountain woodland before reaching the arable and irrigated farmland belonging to Güejar Sierra and finally the river Genil itself.

SUMMER (from 13th July to 25th August)

ROUTE: BORREGUILES – LLANO APARATO – MONTEBAJO (18KM, 2hrs, 600m slope.)

Access from Pradollano to Borreguiles via tarmac road, then move onto dirt tracks towards the lower TS lagoon before stopping at the Llano del Aparato. In this spot we can contemplate the Chorreras del Molinillo cascade, the River Dílar and the whole massif of El Cartujo. We return to the Montebajo area and then descend to Pradollano. This route lasts approximately an hour and a half.

ROUTE: LAGUNA DE LAS YEGUAS

(20KM, 2hrs, 770m slope.)

The same access to Borreguiles as the previous route before taking the dirt track which leads to the col of Laguna de las Yeguas and the lagoon itself. From there we retrace our steps to Borreguiles and then you get to choose the descent to Pradollano; either go back via the tarmac road or through the Montebajo area, the Río slope or the Directa y Boulevares slope.

ROUTE: PEÑONES DE SAN FRANCISO CRAGS

(13KM, 1.30hrs, 400m slope.)

Leave behind Pradollano, passing through the Sierra Nevada residential area to the University Mountain Lodge. Ride through the San Francisco crags and come down to the Plaza de Andalucía square via the Parador and Boulevares.

ROUTE: LAS SABINAS SADDLE - FUENTE ALTA

(7.5KM, 1hr, 100m slope.)

Take the road out of Pradollano towards the saddle Las Sabinas. From the saddle we get onto the Fuente Alta circuit and return to Pradollano. This is an easy route; half asphalt and half paths through the pine woods at Fuente Alta with very little gradient.

ROUTE: VELETA SUMMIT

(40KM, 3hrs, 1350m slope.)

Classic road ascent from Pradollano to the summit of El Veleta and then different descent options to Pradollano to choose from on route.

Use of comfortable mountain footwear, sun cream, sun glasses and water is obligatory.

Pick up from the Plaza de Andalucía Square meeting point (time to be confirmed on booking) Transfer to the summit of El Veleta from where you can witness a spectacular sunrise or sunset, enjoy a brief talk from our guide at more than 3000m above sea level. The activity ends with the return transfer to Pradollano.

This activity will consist of an interpretation of the night sky and an astronomical observation using a large portable telescope guided by an astronomer from the Azimuth team, to be carried out in the surroundings of the Fuente Alta Area (near Pradollano).

Would you like to get closer to the cosmos with the help of an astronomer from Sierra Nevada?

Accompanied by one of the astronomers from the Azimuth team, and from the spectacular setting of Fuente Alta in the vicinity of Pradollano, you will have the opportunity to enjoy the starry sky of Sierra Nevada, and observe through the latest technology in large portable telescopes, stars that hide secrets you wouldn't expect, see other galaxies from our local universe, and if possible, even planets as spectacular as Saturn! We look forward to seeing you.

IMPORTANT:

This visit takes place in a high mountain environment above 2,500 meters above sea level, which is why it is not recommended for people with heart problems or respiratory problems as well as for elderly people.

During the activity, you must always be accompanied by the authorised guide.

DISCOVER THE MOON FROM SIERRA NEVADA

JULY: 19th and 20th, from 10:30 pm to 12:30 am **AUGUST:** 16th, from 10:00 pm to 12:00 am

This activity will consist of an interpretation of the night sky and an astronomical observation using a large portable telescope guided by an astronomer from the Azimuth team, to be carried out in the surroundings of the Fuente Alta Area (near Pradollano).

Get closer to the Moon from the spectacular sky of Sierra Nevada! The Moon is probably the most spectacular object that can be observed through a telescope. Accompanied by one of the astronomers from the Azimuth team, we want you to observe its ancient lava-flooded plains, impact craters hundreds of kilometers in diameter with walls rising thousands of meters, or even the remains of ancient volcanic tubes. All this enlivened with the interesting science and planetary knowledge we have gained from the study of our natural satellite.

IMPORTANT:

This visit takes place in a high mountain environment above 2,500 meters above sea level, which is why it is not recommended for people with heart problems or respiratory problems as well as for elderly people. During the activity, you must always be accompanied by the authorised guide. Activity dependent on weather conditions.

DAYTIME VISIT TO THE SIERRA NE-VADA OBSERVATORY

JULY: SATURDAY 27th

AUGUST: SATURDAYS 3rd and 17th

Discover the Sierra Nevada Observatory, its facilities, and the science conducted from this scientific infrastructure.

The Sierra Nevada Observatory is a scientific facility under the Institute of Astrophysics of Andalusia (IAA-CSIC), and it is the highest-altitude active optical astronomical observatory in Europe. It is located in the Sierra Nevada National Park, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, so just exploring this environment is a treat for the senses.

During the visit, you will have access to the interior of the Sierra Nevada Observatory to visit the two main telescopes with apertures of 1.5 m and 0.9 m, as well as the main control room. We will tell you about its history and, of course, the scientific projects carried out with these telescopes and their associated scientific instruments.

The ascent to the observatory will be by cable car from Pradollano to the Borreguiles area, and then by chairlift to an altitude of 3,000 meters above sea level. From there, we will walk about two kilometers to the observatory, passing through the Laguna de las Yeguas area.

Starting at 4:45 p.m., after the visit, we will return to the Borreguiles area to take the cable car back to Pradollano.

IMPORTANT:

This visit takes place in a high mountain environment above 2,500 meters above sea level, so it is not recommended for people with heart or respiratory problems, as well as for elderly people. The observatory does not have medical assistance on its premises.

During the visit, you must always be accompanied by authorised guides.

This activity is dependent on weather conditions as well as the operation of mechanical facilities (cable car, chairlift).

It is essential to come with enough warm clothing and appropriate mountain footwear.

Use of comfortable mountain footwear, sun cream, sun glasses and water is obligatory. Warm clothing, recommended.



THE LAGOONS OF SIERRA NEVADA WITH CHAIRLIFT

A guided route that takes us to the lagoons of Las Yeguas and De La Virgen. This is an easy walk which covers from the base of Veleta peak to the lagoons: about 6 km in approx. 3 hours. The gondola and chairlift take us to the base of Veleta then with our guides we get to know the flora, fauna, landscapes and history that surround us along this beautiful route. Suitable for: all public (minimum physical condition required) Distance: Approx. 6 km

Schedule: 09.00h - Reception in Dornajo Visitor Centre. 09.30h: Gondola to Pradollano. 10.00h: Start walk. 11.30h: Rest and refreshments (BYO). 14.00h: Arrive back at Dornajo Visitor Centre. Includes: Nature walk guide, authorisations and insurance.

20TH JULY / 18TH AUGUST / 7TH SEPTEMBER

Climb to the highest peak of the Peninsula, El Mulhacén (3479m) This is a one-day route, via the SIAC (North) we reach our stating point at Posiciones del Veleta. The walk is approximately 22km with an accumulated slope of 711m. Recommendations: This route is of a medium-high difficulty, so we recommend that all participants be over 12 years old, in good physical condition and used to mountain walking.

Important: Hiking boots and poles, windcheater or warm top layer, sun cream food and water are essential. Depart: 08.30hrs Hoya de la Mora in shuttle bus/van to Posiciones del Veleta where we begin our walk.

A not-difficult climb up to the Veleta peak (3398m.) Using Sierra Nevada resort's lifts, this is an unforgettable experience for all publics. Due to the demand in leisure and sporting activities set in high mountain, El Dornajo Visitor Centre offers several guided walks to the most emblematic peaks of Sierra Nevada. One of the most popular and accessible is El Veleta peak (3398m,) the second highest peak of Sierra Nevada and third of all the Iberian Peninsula. The route starts in El Dornajo Visitor Centre, from there participants make their own way to Pradollano where we take the gondola and chairlifts to reach Posiciones del Veleta. The walk is approximately 9km with a 489m slope.
